The Mossy Forest of Gunung Brinchang is a moist tropical evergreen forest. It sits at the highest part of Cameron Highlands. At this height, low clouds cover the forest with moisture and mist. This creates an ideal environment for moss, ferns, and orchids to grow and for snakes, frogs, insects, birds, and mammals, which are **adapted** to the cool atmosphere, to live.

There is a wooden platform built through the forest for visitors to walk on as they explore the forest. Besides layers of moss on the mountain floor and tree trunks, there are orchids, pitcher plants, and vines hanging loosely from the tree tops and branches.

However, the Mossy Forest is now closed to visitors and will remain so till the middle of 2016.
